

Noteworthy Features of 2398 Old Perth Road

Built in 1990

Slab on grade construction

2.38 acre lot - sketch available

Septic documentation available

Well record available

Irregular lot

Oversized 2-car garage with overhead storage and covered breezeway to home

Screened gazebo with hydro

Former sugar shack (equipment has been removed) now serves as storage

Newer flooring on lower level, extra material available if Buyer wants to do bathroom floor

Newer flooring, mixed species hardwood, in living/dining

Bright home with plenty of natural light

Cozy gas fireplace with stacked stone façade (2017)

Large, bright kitchen with eating area, island, plenty of built-ins, pull-outs and fabulous pantry

Hot water on demand tap – perfect for tea drinkers!

3 season sunroom with Weatherwall system

Glass panels on Trex deck ensure unobstructed views

Plenty of built-ins in den off kitchen

Plenty of built-ins in primary bedroom plus walk-in closet and 5 piece ensuite

Septic tank pumped in 2020

Roof & skylights (2013) 30 year shingles

Skylights resealed (2016)

Air to air heat pump (2016) – heating and cooling – one bill no noisy air conditioning unit, serviced regularly

Furnace – back up electric serviced regularly

Propane fireplace (2017) serviced regularly

Pressure tank (2017)

200 amp service, copper, wired for generator

Windows – upper level thermal panes replaced (2017) except for den

Windows – (2021) new kitchen bay window and 2 lower level bedrooms

Property has buried invisible dog fencing

Approximately \$2,500 hydro with Hydro One (note no separate fuel bill due to heat pump)

Approximately \$350 per annum for propane (fireplace)
